Participation

1) The host withholds the right to cancel categories or to limit the number of competitors, if the number of registrations exceeds capacity especially in accordance with the Covid-19 regulations.

2) Registered athletes for assessment of approval for the national squad **NK2** of the DEU in the category **Advanced Novice and Junior** have priority and must be indicated on the registration form.

Registration must be made exclusively by the Regional Association (Landes-Eissport-Verband). Here the report must be made via the respective club (incl. Registration list). The registration of the participants of German clubs must be made on the provided DEU form, (see Appendix). Before registration, validation of the data via the DEU Data Assistant at http://deu-info.de/datenassistent/excel-validieren must be completed.

Corona

The host reserves the right to cancel the **Heiko Fischer Trophy 2024** if due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) the decision or recommendation of the national/local Government will not agree to conduct such an event. **In case of cancellation of the event by the host due to corona regulations, the entry fee will be refunded.**

Individual Results

The marking system (ISU Judging System) will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications. The three best-placed skaters in each category will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. Medals will be awarded to all other participants at the Victory Ceremony. By registering for the competition, the skater agrees resp. the legal representative of the skater agree to the publishing of the results on the internet.

Media/Internet

Entry lists, results, photos, videos of athletes and livestream of the event will be published on the internet. With Competition Registration, the athlete or the athlete's legal representative agrees to the publication of name, results, photos and videos.

Judges

Participating clubs or associations are asked to supply one judge per team/ LEV with the minimum qualification "National championships". All costs (hotel, travelling, external food) for judges must be paid by the registering club or association. The organizer withholds the right to choose the panel of judges.

Music

The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats by e-mail to musik@eissportverband-bw.de no later than February 10, 2024. Any other format is not acceptable. Each submission must be labelled with the name of category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s) EXACTLY as follows: Example:
